4 Days 3 Nights tour in Phnom Penh

Day 1: ARR-PNH (-/L/D)

TRAVEL & TOURS

Pick up from airport and transfer to your hotel, visit the **Independent Monument**, and the **Royal Palace**, built by King Norodom in 1866 on the site of the old town, and the **Silver Pagoda**. Located within the grounds of the Royal Palace, the Silver Pagoda is so named because of its floor, which is made up of 5000 silver tiles. Lunch at restaurant, visit of the **National Museum**, also called Musee des Beaux-Arts and the **Wat Phnom** Temple, Phnom Penh's namesake, from where you can enjoy views over the tree-lined avenues of the city. Visit to **Sisowath Quay** and a well-known **NAGA world casino** where you can visit & enjoy many games inside. Dinner at restaurant and accommodation at hotel

Day 2: PNH (B/L/D)

Breakfast at hotel, visit the Notorious **Tuol Sleng Museum**, In 1975 Tuol Svay Prey High School was taken over by Pol Pot's security forces and turned into a prison known as Security Prison 21 (S-21). Visit to **Killing Fields of Choeung EK** just outside Phnom Penh about a 20-40 minute was an orchard and a Chinese cemetery prior to 1975. During the Khmer Rouge regime it became one of the killing fields. Lunch at restaurant, visit to the **Russian Market** (Psah Tuol Thom Pong), a lively outdoor market where you will find antiquities, silver and gold jewelry, gems, silk, kramas, stone and wood carvings, as well as T-Shirts, CDs till dinner at restaurant and accommodation at hotel

Day 3: PNH (B/L/D)

Breakfast at hotel; visit the Capital of Cambodia between 1618 & 1866. **Phnom Udong**: About an hour west of Phnom Penh, just off Route # 5, lay the hills of the abandoned royal city. Several temples, stupas and other structures cover three hills. The walk up the hill provides an excellent countryside view. These hills were also the site of some of the Khmer Rouge's most prolonged resistance against the encroaching Vietamese army in 1979. Transfer back to Phnom Penh for lunch at local restaurant, on the way back you can visit the **Silver Village** and **Cambodian Countryside** living life. After lunch, free & easy till end your trip with **1hour Mekong River cruise** along the riverfront.

Day 4: PNH-DEP (B/-/-)

Breakfast at hotel, transfer to airport for departure.
